## THE GROW RICH SYSTEM

## RULES

- I. Any daily paper giving racing details can be used.
- 2. The System works only on Handicap Chases and Handicap Hurdle races.
- 3. If a horse is ridden by an amateur jockey, ignore it.
- 4. Look at the bottom of the list of race runners in all Handicap Hurdles and Chaces and note any horse which won on its last outing this current season, and also has a penalty weight shown against its name on the card. You then note the weight that the bottom horse is carrying (minimum wieght for the race, i.e. lOst, 7lbs.), then on to this weight you add the penalty weight. If those two weights, when added together, are greater than the weight allotted to the horse for the race, then his horse is a selection to be backed, i.e.:
  - (a) it must have won its last race in the current season:
  - (b) the weight allotted must be less than the minimum weight for the race (IOst or IOst 7lbs.) plus the penalty weight when these are added together:
  - (c) the horse must not be ridden by an amateur jockey.

In the case of it being shown in the paper that the weights have been raised for any system race (which is notified above the list of runners and riders for the race), then in such a case you simply deduct the number of pounds for which the weights have been raised from the allotted weight given to the horse for the race.

For instance, say it was shown that for a race the weights were raised and the system horse was detailed as follows:

OO2-I HARVEST GOLD (7lbs extra) ... race weight IOst. I2 lbs.

BOTTOM HORSE ... race weight IOst..

In this case, by deducting IO lbs from IOst I2 lbs., this leaves IOst 2 lbs, and so the original weight was IOst 2 lbs before the weights were raised, so as the system horse carries less weight than the minimum plus its penalty weight, this is, of course, a system selection.

5. The system horse must not carry the minimum weight at any time, and if it does so it does not qualify as a selection. It must be between the minimum weight for the race (IOst or IOst 7 lbs.) and the weight after you add its penalty weight on to the minimum weight.
