# The Smart Profits Roulette System

"Your Manual for Continuous Unprecedented Wealth"

#### Introduction

Gambling is simple. This is the concept I've learnt the hard way over the past few years. During my early gambling years I consistently lost cash on a regular basis by implementing some pretty rudimentary "systems". Needless to say I encountered very little success.

The mistake I frequently made was the ineffective gaming methods I attempted to implement. Gambling is not an exact science – it is of course merely gambling! Any complex systems that encourage long analysis of a roulette wheel will probably fail. After all, each spin of the wheel is an isolated event. However, is it conceivable that a sequence of 20 odd numbers, 50 black numbers or 10 single numbers will regularly appear on any table? In my experience it is not.

I decided therefore to modify and amend a couple of methods I previously used to gamble in the casino. The result was the methods I'm presenting to you which frequently earn me a daily profit.

Anyway before proceeding I'd just like to say thanks very much for your purchase. If you encounter any problems implementing the program please feel free to contact me for assistance. # **System Logistics**

Your win target is 70 units. Once you've achieved this target you cease playing that session. You have a loss limit of 100 units and once (hopefully not very often!) you have lost these units you also cease to continue in that session.

You will begin with a bankroll that will fluctuate depending on your success in that session and you must pass the 70 unit mark before you cease playing. Likewise if you're losing 99 units you should proceed until all of your 100 units have been lost. On several occasions I've managed to secure a successful session when I've previously been losing heavily!

### It is these two principals that are the backbone of the strategy.

Okay, let's proceed with the system logistics. You will be playing 9 straight numbers on the wheel; a single unit on each number. You will play an exact set of 9 numbers until a win has been secured. You will then progress to another cluster of 9 numbers. If a win isn't secured, you will continue to play until 5 straight losses have been recorded. You then shift to the next cluster of 9 numbers. You play them in the same way as the previous group.

In summary; if you witness a win, **move on**. If you don't secure a win in 5 spins, **move on**.

### Single zero roulette strategy (European)

You will play the 9 numbers in the following sequence:

## **Double zero roulette strategy (American)**

You will play the nine numbers in the following sequence:

You can clearly see that there are 12 groups of 9 numbers. These groups of 9 numbers will be played in 12 stages. For instance, on a double zero (00) wheel your first play will be on these numbers: 0, 00, 1, 2, 3, 13, 14, 15 & 24.

When you've secured a win you then shift your focus onto the level below which is: 4, 5, 6, 16, 17, 18, 21, 22 & 23. If you lose the first 5 spins of these sequences you then shift to the next cluster of 9 numbers.

Win a spin; shift to the next cluster of 9 numbers.

**Lose a spin 5 successive times**; shift to the next cluster of 9 numbers.

When you have completed all 12 stages return to the beginning. When you reach a profit of 70 units (or more) cease playing. Likewise if you lose 100 units or more cease playing.

It's advisable to record your profit and loss and thus record your position after every spin. When you secure a win, add 27. When you witness a loss, subtract 9.

#### For example:

L -9 L -18 W 9 L 0 W 27 W 54 L 45 W 72

In the above example we would then finish our play because we've secured our 70 unit target.

I suggest that during each trip to the casino you should play at least 3 sessions. After these sessions evaluate your results. In essence your objective should be to secure profits from 2 of the 3 sessions. If you win on 2 or 3 continue to play. If not your next 3 sessions should be played with 2 chips on each number.

After these sessions have been completed once again evaluate your position. If you win at least 2 of the 3 games then revert to a single chip on each number for the next 3 sessions. You must always win at least 2 of the 3 sessions. If you don't then increase your outlay by one extra chip on the next 3 plays. When you eventually win reduce your next sessions by a single chip.

I'll use an example.

Let's assume you've experienced a poor run. You're now playing 3 chips per number. You play 3 sessions with this outlay and proceed to win 2 of the 3 sessions. You now play your next three sessions at 2 chips per number. Again, let's assume you win 2 of the 3 sessions. You will now revert back to a single chip per number on the next 3 sessions.

If you keep winning 2 out of 3 in each session you'll always outlay 1 chip per number. You only ever increase your outlay when you failed to secure 2 or more sessions from the 3. When playing more than 1 chip per number, you still regard that outlay as a single unit. So if you have 3 chips on a single number, when you calculate the profit/loss you class those chips as 1 unit.

The bankroll required for this system will obviously vary depending on your unit value. I always try and envisage what the worst outcome will be and therefore try and sufficiently cover any possible long losing runs. I would suggest a minimum 500 units.

And that's it! The Smart Profit roulette system.
